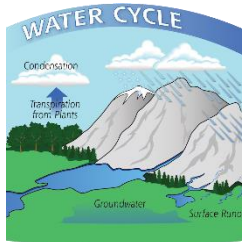
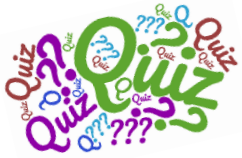
## Year 6 – Coastal erosion

### Enquiry Questions

What kind of King was Jesus?

How does light travel?

How does water affect the landscapes we live on?



### National Curriculum –

In Science, we are learning about light and how it travels including refraction and reflections and the Science behind these.

This half term in RE, we will be exploring the question 'What Kind of King was Jesus?' linking the bible's teachings surrounding this.

In PE, we will be doing athletics and practicing for our upcoming Sport's Day using various skills.

For Computing, the children will be creating quizzes and thinking about how to reliably collect the information to create these.

In Geography, we will be revisiting the water cycle and looking into erosion and how water changes landscapes over time.

In French, we are covering Healthy Lifestyle introducing new vocabulary.

### English - Reading

We will be looking at past papers in the SATs and using these to guide children through test techniques and how to answer questions effectively.

### English - Writing

The children will be completing short revision sessions on the key components of mathematics ranging from angles through to fractions, decimals and percentages.
